In order to stay in line with our Covid risk assessments, to minimise risk at all cost, we are inviting only:

ONE ADULT PER FAMILY to each performance.

For example, this means Mam can attend at 10.00am and Dad can attend at 2.00pm.

We understand that this may be disappointing for our families, however a lot of schools are not inviting parents into school at all and we are not in a position to allow a larger audience. We found this to be the **ONLY** way we are able to permit parents to experience this wonderful event.

Please note, we are not allocating tickets and instead, we are trusting parents/carers to stick to the rules we have set. Adult's names will be marked against children's names on the door and unfortunately, any extra adults will be declined entry. Gates will be opened 15mins before the event, to allow time for us to take adults names. Please note, we must record adults names attending the performance for track and trace purposes.
